Community Futures Bursary

The Community Futures Peace Country (CFPC) Bursary Program is an opportunity for Grade 12 students who intend to further their studies in a field related to business and/or economic development, to develop an initiative or project that addresses an issue in their community. This "idea" must be original and not duplicate current initiatives being implemented in the region.

Essays can be developed using any idea that would make your community a better place. For example, a project might include ways to retain and attract young people to rural communities, a business opportunity that would enhance the town, or ways to promote your community as a tourism destination.

A \$500 Bursary* is available to Grade 12 students that:

- ✍ Currently are schooled and reside in the CFPC service region.
- ✍ Enrolled for fall of 2008 in a full-time post-secondary program in business, economics, politics or Community Economic Development.

*In partnership with the Northern Alberta Development Council (NADC) students are eligible for matching amount of funds up to an additional \$500 for a total of a maximum of \$1000 per bursary. Please call CFPC for details.
